Minutes of ACTC meeting, 21st November, 2019: Fencing Association of India (FAI)

The ACTC meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Shri. Radhey Shyam Julaniya, Secretary (Sports) to consider ACTC and budget request for **Fencing Association of India (FAI)**.

List of members present in the meeting is at **the end**.

2. At the outset Secretary (Sports) stated that Fencing being a medal prospect for 2024 and 2028 Olympics, the ACTC calendar and budget would be approved up to June 2021.

3. President, FAI made following commitments, which were included as binding decisions as a part of approved ACTC calendar and budget:-

3.1 FAI would ensure conducting of State level competitions as per the calendar.

3.2 FAI would make its best efforts to achieve the following targets:

3.3. FAI would make its best efforts for early talent scouting. Various sporting events such as Inter-district, State and National Level Competitions and National Open Championship would be held for identification of talent. FAI would submit a comprehensive proposal for financial assistance in this regard **by 20th January, 2020** to DG, SAI which would be funded under Khelo India.


3.4. FAI would focus upon the administrative improvements in the State Associations so that 100% districts would take part in their State level competitions by the year 2022-23. However, year wise commitment, for good participation is as under. The list of 150 Districts for the year 2019-20 will be submitted by **10th January 2020**.

2019 - 20	150 districts in India
2020 - 21	200 districts in India
2021 - 22	250 districts in India
2022 - 23	300 districts in India

3.5. FAI has submitted the list of 07 centres to be developed as high performance centre for fencing and would start with 03 centres: ASI Pune for boys, NIS Patiala for girls and SAG Centre Nadiad for both (Boys & Girls). These three centres are to be established by 31st March 2020. An amount of Rs. 3 crore (Rs. Three Crore) for each centre will be provided from Khelo India. Since, ASI has all the facilities, third centre will be finalised by FAI & SAI. Subsequently, two to three centres will be established per year in 2021-22 and 2022-23.

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The list of total 07 centres is as follows:

- a. NIS Patiala (Girls)
- b. ASI Pune (Boys)
- c. SAG Centre Nadiad (Boys & Girls)
- d. MP State Govt. Centre
- e. SAI Aurangabad
- f. SAI Centre Imphal,
- g. SAI Centre, Tellicherry, Kerala

Details of equipments to be procured for 01 (one) centre are attached as Annexure 'A'.

3.6. FAI would submit the name of 50 District Centres as Intermediate Performance Centres for which Rs. 5.00 lakh for each centre will be provided for the equipments from Khelo India. The list of proposed centres will be submitted by **31st January, 2020.**

3.7. FAI would engage 03 High Performance Manager (01 for each event i.e. Epee, Foil and Sabre) and would invite the Foreign Experts through open advertisement on their website as well as on the website of the International Federation by **31st January, 2020.**

3.8. FAI has indentified coaches and support staff for the academies being setup. Salary of the coaches and support staff will be decided as per the decision of the DPAC of Khelo India. Recurring expenditure of the academies will be funded by Khelo India. **List of coaches and support staff is attached as Annexure 'B'.**

3.9. FAI would submit the list of academies run by renowned coaches/International players with the possibilities of agreement with SAI up to 2028 to promote fencing at grass-root level by **31st January, 2020.**


3.10. FAI would submit the Curriculum -Vitae of Col. Vikram Singh Jamwal, Indian Army, Former International Fencer and currently advisor to FAI, who may work with SAI/FAI as Chief Executive Officer for Fencing by **05th January, 2020.**


3.11. FAI would start a monthly Domestic or Ranking tournaments for National level fencers from February, 2020 onward.

3.12. FAI would organise One International Competition in India with the collaboration of International Federation to give maximum exposure to the Indian Fencers. **Details are attached as Annexure 'C'.**

3.13. The committee has approved the request of FAI to provide Financial Assistance of Rs. 20 lakh (Rs. Twenty Lakh) to Ms. Bhavani Devi for participation in qualifying tournaments for Olympics. FAI will submit proposals within the specified amount with detailed tour program.

3.14. It was decided that there is no funding for junior camps and junior trainees will be trained at Khelo India Academies.

3.15. Under the senior category, there will be foreign exposures for the senior team comprising 30 players and 06 coaches for each tournament, within a budgetary limit of Rs. 1.50 crore (Rs. One Crore Fifty Lakh Only). **The list of International Exposures for Senior is attached as Annexure 'D'.**

3.16. For the junior category, the training programme has been designed in such a way so that the players can participate in training programmes along with tournament, each team comprising 30 players and 06 coaches/support staff for each tournament, within a budgetary limit of Rs. 3 Crore (Rs. Three Crore). The list of International Exposures for Junior is attached as Annexure 'E'.


Budget allocated for junior category may be utilised for senior category, if good junior fencers perform better and are able to move to senior category.

4. Other salient decisions are as below:

- 4.1 Equipments and consumables for Fencing to be procured in a time bound manner to ensure timely availability for procurement following to be done:-
- FAI would procure in a competitive and transparent manner. Project officer of SAI would be a member in the procurement committee.
 - For procurement of equipments a gap analysis at Centres would be carried out by FAI in consultation with representative of SAI. Procurement will be done to bridge the gaps in equipments.
 - For procurement of above equipments and consumables respectively, SAI would release 50% of the budgeted amount as grant under Khelo India Scheme to FAI as in advance. The balance would be released on submission of proof of procurement/utilization certificate. FAI would maintain inventory and record of equipments and consumables. Any equipment having life of more than two years would be housed in SAI Centres and handed over to SAI Regional Centres where camps are approved in the calendar. In the first year centres will start with 150 fencers (50 fencers- 25 boys & 25 girls in each centre) and by the end of third year strength would be increased to 750 fencers.
 - While procuring equipments and consumables quantity should be used for getting competitive prices but inventory should not be allowed to accumulate. FAI as well as SAI representative in its committee would ensure this.
- 4.2 SAI infrastructure and sports facilities, if available, would be provided for State and National level competitions free of cost as per the policy.
- 4.3 Department of Sports would grant necessary sanction for coach, referee and judge development under HRDS. FAI would submit a comprehensive proposal to Director (Sports) **by 31st January 2020**. 75% of the cost for upgrading knowledge/skills and acquiring higher level accreditation from International Federation would be funded under HRDS, with a condition that the beneficiary participant pays 25%. In case of SAI coaches, remaining 25% cost would be reimbursed to those who succeed in

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acquiring higher level accreditation along with their TA/DA. SAI would ensure participation of all SAI coaches in the programme.

- 4.4 Total budget of **Rs. 16.94 Crore (Rs. Sixteen crore ninety four lakh only)** was approved for FAI up to June 2021. The breakup of amount is as follows:

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
