Minutes of the ACTC 2021-22 - 08th June 2021: Fencing Association of India (FAI)

The ACTC meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Shri. Ravi Mital, IAS, Secretary (Sports) on 08th June 2021 via video conferencing to consider ACTC and budget request for Fencing Association of India (FAI) for the period July 2021 to March 2022. List of members present in the meeting is at the end.

2. Fencing Association of India (FAI) made following commitments and targets for Indian Fencers which were included as binding decisions as a part of approved ACTC and budget:



3. Secretary (Sports) appreciated the efforts of the FAI in giving the detailed presentation. Further, it was noted that considering the importance of Fencing and its impact on the Olympic Games given the number of medals (36 medals) vis-à-vis the overall position of India, Fencing as a sports discipline was moved to 'Priority Olympic Discipline' from the 'Others' category with concomitant Annual Calendar for Training and Competition (ACTC).

4. Furthermore, it was also noted that in order to provide the leverage towards long-term plan, an amount of Rs. 11.50 crores were sanctioned to FAI for procurement of equipment at 03 High Performance Centres (@ Rs. 3.00 Crores per HPC) and 50 Intermediate Performance Centres (@ Rs. 5 Lakhs per IPC) from Khelo India Scheme in the previous year (2020-2021).

5. The total budget for the annual calendar for training and competition was approved for FAI up to March 2022 with a cap of **Rs. 3,00,00,000/- (Rupees Three Crores Only)** restricting the budget to the actual expenditure incurred during 2018-19. It was noted that since the proposed Annual Calendar of Training & Competition was approved with change in the overall budget, a



review would be undertaken in September/October 2021, for any additional requirement of funds subject to availability of budget under the 'Assistance to NSF' Scheme. The approved calendar is at **Annexure I**.

6. Other salient decisions are as below:


- i. DG, SAI was authorized to approve changes in budget arriving out of any alteration in dates/number of athletes in National Coaching Camps and Foreign Exposure (Training and Competition) owing to changes made by The Fédération Internationale d'Esime (FIE).
- ii. Domestic Competition structure would be approved as per current 'Assistance to NSF' norms, i.e., @ Rs. 22 lakh per year for organising Senior, Junior and Sub-Junior National Championships. However, if the norms are revised, the revised norms shall be applicable for conducting the domestic competitions.
- iii. In addition to the above, the proposal for Coach, Referee and Technical Official Development Programme shall be taken separately under **Human Resource Development Scheme (HRDS)**. Further, FAI was requested that the Coach Education programme should be upgraded as per international standards in collaboration with FIE.

7. In addition to the above, proposal for hiring of Foreign Coaches to be processed by FAI separately under 'Support to National/Regional/State Sports Academies' component of Khelo India. The details are placed at **Annexure - II**.

8. The calculation has been done as per the existing MYA&S norms for financial assistance to National Sports Federation.

9. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
